

Writing Contest and Electronic Publication

The English Department at Wright State University's Lake Campus and the College Community Arts Council are co-sponsoring an electronic publication to be called *A Gathering of Young Writers*.

The author of the best piece of writing in each issue will receive a \$100 award.

The publication will appear three times a year—at the end of the fall, winter, and spring. The deadlines for each issue will be December 15, March 1, and May 1.

A Gathering of Young Writers will include the best writing submitted by middle-school and high-school students or their teachers in the ten-county West Central Ohio region (Allen, Auglaize, Darke, Hardin, Logan, Mercer, Paulding, Putnam, Shelby, and Van Wert counties).

Please put "Writing Contest" on the subject line, and please attach each submission as a Word (doc or docx) or Rich Text (rtf) file.

In the message box, please provide the student's name, grade, school, and teacher's name. And, if it is not sent from a personal e-mail account, the message should include an e-mail to which a response can be made.

There are no restrictions on subject, on length, or on the number of submissions by individual students or teachers. In fact, teachers are welcome to send bulk submissions, electronically or on paper. We plan on holding a reception and reading near the end of the school year to honor those whose work has been included in *A Gathering of Young Writers*, including the award winners.
